
ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY

KLID Report

Our monthly meeting's biggest discussion was once again weeds. With all the statewide early ice out conditions this year, the MN DNR has moved some weed spraying dates to allow better control of weeds. In normal years, Curry Leaf Pondweed is treated in May. This year it will be treated in April. Sometime later this month or early next month, a survey will be held that will provide weeded areas & recommendations for treatment will be provided to the KLID. The MN DNR only allows for a maximum of 75 of the 1250 lake acres to be treated. Typically, only 50 acres are treated. That's only 4% of the lake and only in the areas that need to be treated & approved by the property owner.

More on nuisance weeds next month. If you have any questions or concerns, the KLID holds their monthly meeting @ 8am every 3rd Saturday of the month, at the KLSC Clubhouse. Meetings are open to the public. Ed Hamlin, KLSC President & liaison to KLID.

- --No late weigh-in will be counted, so you must be back by 12 PM.
- --Raffle tickets will be available for extra prizes @ \$5 each before contest or during registration of fish.
- --All volunteers are able to enter and compete in the contest, but cannot weigh their own fish.


