7/4/26 - 4th of July events.

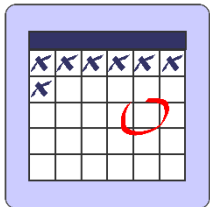

Thank you for your continued support and understanding as we learn more about this process.

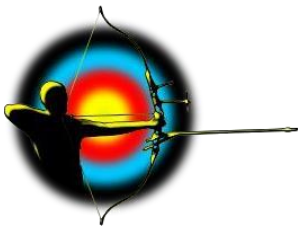
