

Archery Range Safety Rules

Knife Lake Sportsmen's Club Archery Range

SAFETY RULES

- All range users are responsible for safety and safe shooting.
- Field tips only. No broadhead shooting permitted.
- Crossbows cannot be used on course target butts.
- Shooters are responsible for immediately correcting any unsafe conditions.
- Shooting is permitted ONLY when: Safe shooting conditions exist.
- No running allowed on the range.
- All shooting is to be into approved target butts only.
- No shooting at unauthorized targets.
- No hunting (the killing/maiming of a live animal is hunting).
- Keep your arrows in the quivers until it is your turn to shoot.
- Arrows may only be knocked on the shooting line.
- Smokers are asked to use provided cans or remove their cigarette butts from the course.
- Alcohol is not allowed on the course.
- Respect other shooters, their equipment, and other park users.
- Handle equipment in a safe manner, with arrows always pointed toward the target.
- Aim at the target and draw your bow – no sky drawing.
- Secure loose clothing. Remove loose items: Jewelry, strings, cords, etc.

This facility is provided as a community benefit. Respect the environment, the natural setting and all users of the park.
